
#### **Subject Specific Skills**

## Key Knowledge: Map of Penketh



#### **Key Vocabulary:**

**Compass:** A special tool that helps you know which direction you are facing.

**Direction:** Where someone or something is pointing or moving.

Fieldwork: Using maps to go out and about to get a practical understanding of something.

**Map:** A specially drawn picture of a place from above. **Symbol:** A picture that represents a word or group of words. They are used on maps to make things clear and easy to find.

**House:** A building that people live in.
